Conditions of entry

1. We invite photographers Worldwide to send up to four prints made by any photographic process.
2. Prints from UK may be mounted or unmounted. Overseas entries should be unmounted. Any mount must be exactly 40 x 50cm (NOT 20 x 16 inches) to fit our glazed frames. Mounted prints thicker than 3mm may not be exhibited or may be shown without glass. Unmounted prints must be printed centrally on A3 (29.7 X 42 cm) paper or be attached centrally to a piece of A3 paper.
3. Each entrant should complete an entry form (or photocopy). Prints must carry on the back (a) the entrant's name and address, (b) the number and title of the print as on the entry form, and (c) for group entries (i.e. more than one entry in a packet), the organiser's name and address.
- 4a. UK Entry fee: £8 per person plus Return Postage (no stamps, please). Group entries – the same.
- 4b. Overseas Entry fee (including Return Postage up to 2kg): £15 Sterling or €18 or US\$25. Group entries: Full fee for the first person, and £9 Sterling or €10 or US\$14 each further person.
- 4c. Do not send prints without entry fees. They will not be judged or returned and no catalogues will be sent.
5. Please enclose fees and entry form with the prints – make UK cheques payable to The London Salon of Photography. Regrettably, overseas cheques and money orders are not acceptable – please send cash. If you wish to pay electronically, please email Secretary who will issue a Paypal invoice
6. Pack prints flat (NOT in rolls). We will return them in the original packing, which should be suitable. Overseas packets must not exceed 2 kg. They must carry the printed address label and be marked Photographs for Exhibition and Return to Sender - No Commercial Value. Packets from countries not in EU must carry green customs forms CN22.
7. We will send to each paid-up entrant: a colour catalogue and a Salon vignette for each accepted print.
8. Copyright remains with the author but we reserve the right to reproduce without payment any print in connection with the exhibition.
9. Every care will be taken of work submitted but we cannot accept responsibility for any damage or loss however caused. Entrants are deemed to accept all these conditions.
10. Members of the Salon are not eligible for medals.

Règlement

1. Le salon est ouvert aux photographes du monde entier. Tous procédés photographiques sont admis. Limite de quatre épreuves par auteur.
2. Les œuvres peuvent être montées ou démontées. Toute épreuve montée, afin de s'accorder avec les cadres sous verre du Salon, sera de dimensions précises mesurant 40 x 50 cm. Toute épreuve démontée est à fournir centralisée et imprimée sur papier A3 (29,7cm par 42cm).
3. Chaque auteur doit envoyer ce bulletin (ou photo-copie) avec ses épreuves. Chaque épreuve portera au dos (a) le nom et l'adresse de l'auteur, (b) le titre de l'œuvre et le numéro d'ordre du bulletin de participation, et (c) pour les envois collectifs (œuvres de plusieurs auteurs dans un seul colis), le nom et l'adresse de l'organisateur.
4. Frais de participation d'outre-mer, y compris port pour le renvoi: €18 ou US\$25 ou £15 Sterling. Envois collectifs: frais réguliers pour le premier auteur, et €10 ou US\$14 ou £9 Sterling pour chacun des autres auteurs.
5. Prière d'envoyer les frais (en billets seulement) et les bulletins de participation avec les épreuves. Nous regrettons qu'il nous est impossible d'accepter d'outre-mer les chèques et autres moyens de paiement. Les épreuves non accompagnées des frais de participation ne seront pas renvoyées.
6. Les épreuves doivent être expédiées à plat (pas enroulées). Renvoi sera dans l'emballage d'origine, qui doit convenir à ceci. Les colis d'outre-mer ne doivent pas dépasser 2kg – ils porteront l'étiquette d'adresse ci-joint ou la mention Photographies d'exposition sans valeur commerciale pour retour à l'exposant. Etiquettes vertes de douane (CN22) sont obligatoires pour les pays hors de l'Union Européenne.
7. Une vignette pour chaque œuvre admise, et un catalogue en couleur seront envoyés à chaque participant.
8. Les droits d'auteur restent la propriété de l'artiste, mais nous réservons le droit de reproduire, sans paiement, toute photo en rapport avec l'exposition.
9. Le London Salon prendra le plus grand soin des œuvres, mais décline toute responsabilité en cas de perte, vol ou détérioration, de cause quelconque. Les exposants doivent accepter toutes ces conditions.
10. Les membres du London Salon ne peuvent pas recevoir de médailles.

Teilnahmebedingungen

1. Fotografen aus aller Welt sind willkommen, dem London Salon bis zu vier Fotos (jegliches fotografische Verfahren, einschliesslich digital) zu senden.
2. Ungefasste Bilder werden bevorzugt. Unterlegte Werke müssen genau 40x50cm messen für die Salon Glasrahmen. Ungefasste Werke müssen zentral auf A3 Papier (29,7 x 42cm) gedruckt sein.
3. Jeder Teilnehmer muss ein Anmeldeformular (oder Fotokopie) einreichen. Alle Fotos sind auf der Rückseite mit folgender Information zu versehen: a) Name und Adresse des Teilnehmers, b) Nummer und Titel des Bildes (übereinstimmend mit dem Anmeldeformular), c) Gruppensendungen: Name und Adresse des Organizers.
4. Teilnahmegebühren Ausland (einschliesslich Rückporto): €18 oder US\$25 oder £15 Sterling. Für Gruppensendungen: Normale Gebühr für den 1. Teilnehmer plus €10 oder US\$14 oder £9 Sterling für alle weiteren Teilnehmer.
5. Den Bildern ist die Teilnahmegebühr sowie das Anmeldeformular beizufügen. Ausländische Schecks und Geldüberweisungen können nicht akzeptiert werden. Einsendungen ohne Teilnahmegebühr können nicht zurückgesandt werden.
6. Die Bilder müssen flach verpackt sein (nicht aufgerollt). Das Verpackungsmaterial muss für die Rücksendung wiederverwendbar sein. Überseepackungen (max. 2kg) müssen entweder den beigefügten Aufkleber oder die Aufschrift Fotos für Ausstellung und Rücksendung an Absender – kein kommerzieller Wert tragen. Pakete ausserhalb der Europäische Union benötigen einen grünen Zollaufkleber (CN22).
7. Alle Teilnehmer erhalten eine Benachrichtigung, Salonetiketts für erfolgreiche Bilder sowie einen illustrierten Farbkatalog.
8. Das Urheberrecht der Bilder verbleibt beim Fotografen; der London Salon hält sich jedoch das Recht vor, Fotos im Zusammenhang mit der Ausstellung ohne Entgelt zu veröffentlichen.
9. Alle Einsendungen werden mit grösster Sorgfalt behandelt. Der London Salon kann für eventuelle Schäden oder Verlust keine Verantwortung übernehmen. Mit Teilnahme erkennt der Einsender alle Bedingungen an.
10. Mitglieder des London Salon können keine Medaillen gewinnen.
